Syracuse, Utica and Binghamton (New York)

This is a Performance Based Contract for Facilities Management, Mechanical Maintenance Services which integrates a Systems Thinking approach for multiple Federal buildings located in Upstate New York.

Approximately 600,000 square feet of interior space – The James M. Handley Federal Building and US Courthouse in Syracuse, NY (16 floors), the Alexander Pirnie Federal Building and US Courthouse in Utica, NY, and the Binghamton Federal Building in Binghamton, NY.

ICE El Centro Service and Processing Center (El Centro, CA)

Contract Number: GS-06F-0068N/HSCEMS-08-A-00005 Contract Value: \$7.2M

This complex is a Department of Homeland Security, Immigration and Custom Enforcement (ICE) processing center for illegal detainees. The complex is comprised of 17 buildings on six acres totaling approximately 150,000 square feet. The contract also had property located in two nearby cities. The main facility, in El Centro, has a 24 hour medical clinic and the entire facility operates 24 hours per day, 365 days per year. The preventive maintenance and the corrective maintenance of the medical equipment and the related HVAC and back-up emergency equipment are vital due to the nature of the facility. The maintenance requirements are complex due to the nature of the processing center. Along with building maintenance responsibilities, our company is also responsible for the pest control, warehouse and stocking of supplies and tools, trash removal, landscaping and custodial operations of the facilities.

Paul Findley Building & US Courthouse (Springfield, IL)

Contract Number: GS05P15SCD0022 Contract Value: \$1.1M

Rosemark provides preventive and corrective operations and maintenance services for this facility. This is a Federal Courthouse that houses the United States District Courts, United States Bankruptcy Courts, US Marshals, US Probation, and US Social Security Hearings Office as its main tenants. The building was built in 1930 which requires delicate, slow repairs to ensure the structure's architectural integrity. Matching today's technology with past construction materials and ways of building requires extra effort on contractors performing work in the building. The facility is heated by a low-pressure steam system that converts about 80% into Hot Water heating through a heat exchanger. Cooling is by two (2) chillers for a VAV system, with cooling tower on lower roof. HVAC, plumbing, electrical work are all performed by the onsite mechanical staff.
